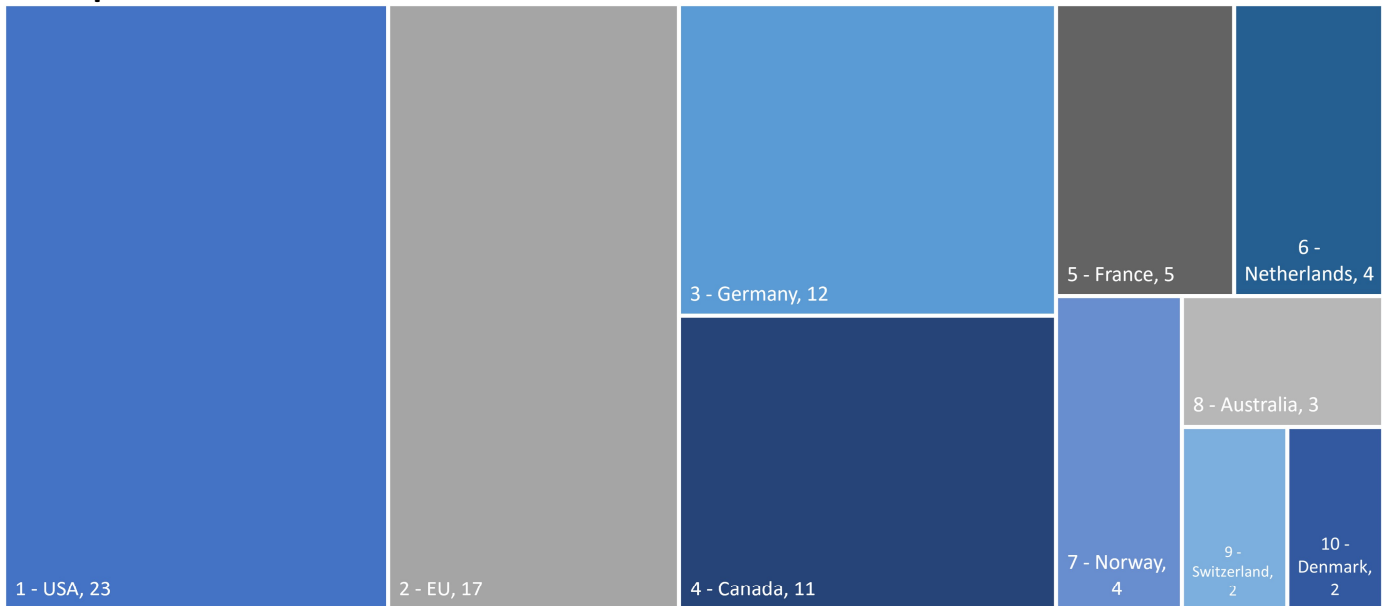

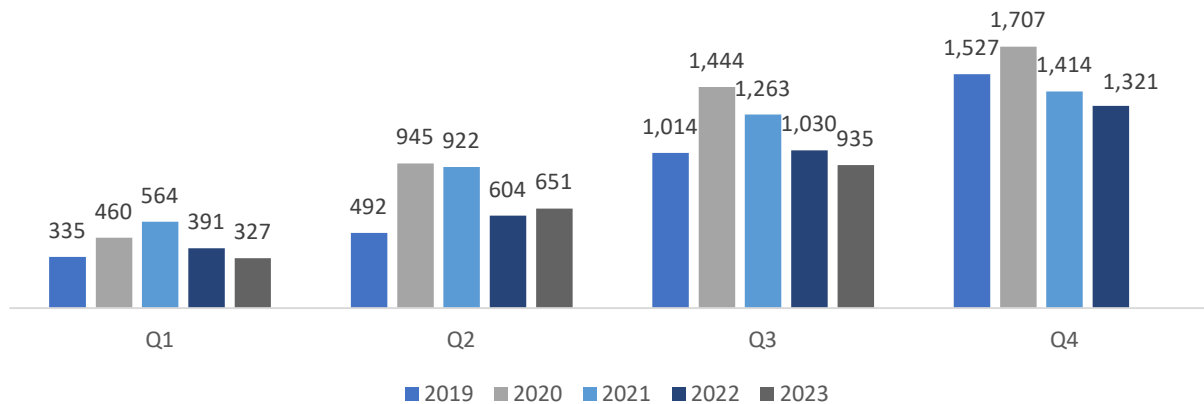

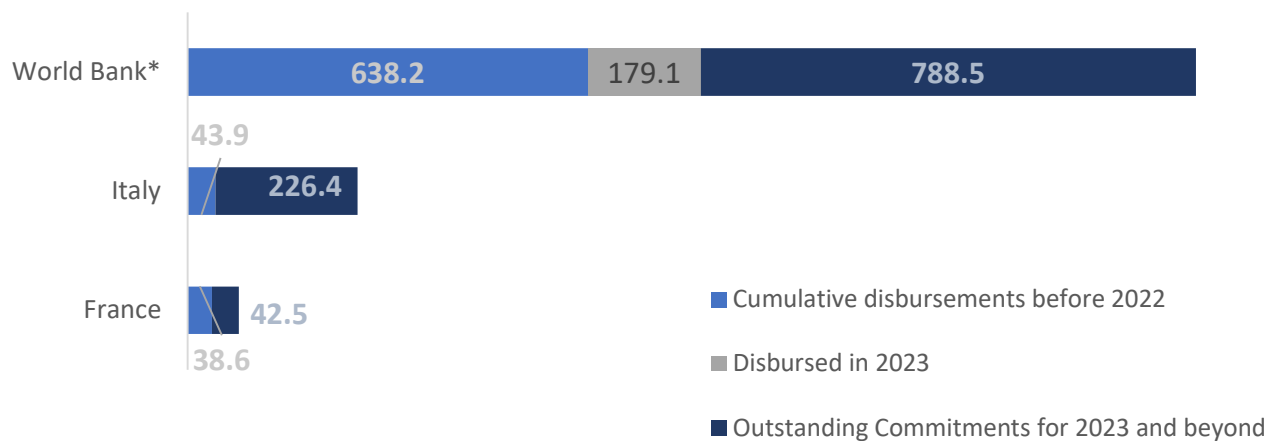
2. Top ten donors disbursed in 2023 in % for Q3
