6. Funding summary for the response to the impact of the Escalations in Lebanon in USD (8 October 2023 - 30 September 2024)

Since the onset of escalations in Lebanon in 2023, the Aid Tracking system monitored new funds received/committed and reprogrammed in support of the response to the escalations. These are funds that supported the emergency response from 8 October 2023 until to 30 September 2024, prior to the launch of the Flash Appeal on 1 October 2024. Starting 1 October 2024, the aid tracking system now monitors funds against the Flash Appeal, reflected in Table 4.
